## Cookie Policy

Welcome to Greenvolt Power. Thank you for visiting our website and we are glad you are here. This is our Cookie Policy. It describes for you the various ways we use certain technologies to collect information about you during your use of our websites located at <https://power.greenvolt.com> (the "Website"). This Cookie Policy does not apply to any other website, service, or application of Greenvolt Power or any websites, services, or applications linked to or from the Website.

In this Cookie Policy, Greenvolt Power is sometimes referred to simply as "Greenvolt", "we", "our", or "us". If you do not agree to terms of this Cookie Policy, you may not use the Website. This Cookie Policy is subject to, and made part of, the Terms of Use available here and our Privacy Policy available here.

### 1. About Cookies

A cookie is a small string of text that a website (or online service) stores on a user's browser. It saves data on your browser about your visit to our Website or other sites. It often includes a unique identifier (e.g., cookie #123).

We may use one or more of the following types of cookies:

- "First-party cookies" are cookies set by us (or on our behalf) on our Website.
- "Third-party cookies" are cookies set by other companies whose functionality is embedded into our Website (e.g., google.com).
- "Session cookies" are temporary cookies stored on your device while you visit our Website. They expire when you close your browser.
- "Persistent cookies" are stored on your browser for a period of time after you leave our Website. Persistent cookies expire on a set expiration date or when they are deleted manually.

### 2. Our Use of Cookies

When visiting the Website we collect standard cookie information so we can track visitor behavior patterns. We do this to monitor how users visit our Website or how long visitors spend in different parts of the Website. We may also use cookies to provide you with certain functionalities or services. This helps us to improve our Website and to plan our future work.

### 3. Google Analytics

We use Google Analytics to collect information about the use of our Website. Google Analytics collects information from users such as how often they visit our Website, what pages they visit, their location, activity on the Website, and what other websites they have used before coming to our Website. Google Analytics collects only the IP address assigned to you on the date you visit our Website, not your name or other identifying

information. Google Analytics also uses specific identifiers to help collect information about the use of our Website.

#### 4. Your Options

You can choose whether to accept cookies by editing your browser settings. However, if cookies are refused, your experience on our Website may be worse, and some features may not work as intended.

- [Safari on desktop](#) and [Safari Mobile \(iPhone and iPads\)](#): Note that, by default, Safari is engineered to protect you from being tracked from site to site unless you disable Intelligent Tracking Prevention (ITP).
- [Firefox](#): By default, Firefox protects you from cross-site tracking so long as you have not disabled Enhanced Tracking Protection (ETP). There is therefore less need to manage cookies to protect your privacy.
- [Microsoft Edge](#): Enabling tracking prevention with Edge will protect you from being tracked between sites, such that there will be less of a need to manage your cookies in order to protect your privacy.
- [Samsung Internet Browser](#): Note that Samsung Internet Browser includes “Smart Watch” protection that works to help protect you from being tracked across sites.
